



2026 Tri-Cities Four-Ball @ Pine Oaks Golf Course

May 30-31

Format: The format is 36 holes of four-ball gross stroke play. Both players will play their own ball and record the lowest score on each hole.

Tees:

- Gold - Male age 49 and below
- Blue - Male age 50-61 / Juniors 13-15
- White – Male age 62-74 / Juniors 12 and under
- Silver – Male 75 and over / Female age 49 and below
- Red – Female age 50 and over

Scoring: Please exchange your scorecard with competitor on your starting hole. After play, you will sign and return your card in the scoring tent. Once signed and turned in, no changes may be made.

Flights: Flights will be determined by your first-round score. Ties may be broken to make the flights an even number. Ties will be decided by the total score on holes 10-18. The lower score(s) may be placed in the lower flight.

Max Improvement: A max improvement from your first round to your second-round score will be implemented. The number of strokes you can improve will be 5 + a roll of a dice, which will be done after the completion of the second round. Example: the dice is rolled and lands on a 3, the max improvement from round one would be 8 (5 +3). Any team that improved by more than the max improvement number will be bumped up a flight.

Ties: Ties may be broken: The total score from holes 10-18 on the second round will be used to break any ties. If there is still a tie, the total from holes 13-18 will be used, then holes 16-18, and finally hole 18.

Rules: USGA Rules will govern play. Out of Bounds (white stakes, off golf course property, and all roadways/parking lots). Drop zone on 7, 9, 13 and 14 (ball over green in penalty areas). For rulings you may call 423-747-4974

Weather: If inclement weather occurs, a horn will be blown to signal a suspension of play. All players must stop playing and evacuate the course.

Team Payout: 30% of each flight will be paid out in gift certificates redeemable at Pine Oaks GC.
